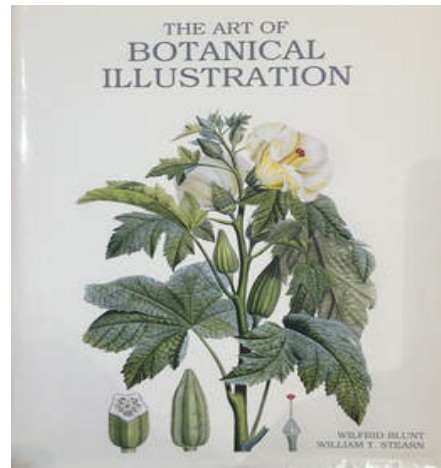
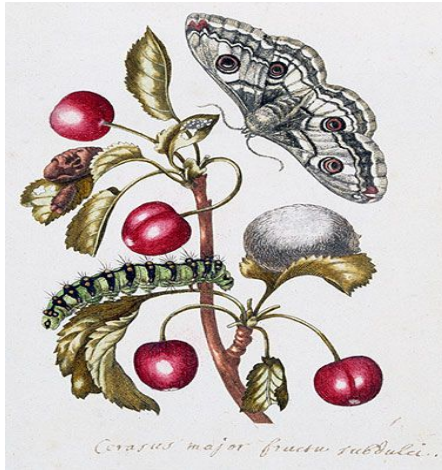


# The Art of Botanical Illustration
