

Landscape

Description:

Photograph a landscape scene, but arrange your shot(s) using the Rule of Thirds.

Keys to Success:

- Consider where you want to place the horizon line in your picture:
 - Place it on the top third line to focus on the foreground?
 - Place it on the bottom third line to focus on the sky?
- If you have a particular subject or center of interest, be sure to place it on a left or right third line as well.
- Make use of the Crop tool in Lightroom or Photoshop when you return to refine your composition.

Upon Completion of this Assignment:

You should end up with a nice landscape shot. If you live in a rural environments, you will have a leg up for this assignment; but if you live in a city there are always parks in which you can shoot. The Rule of Thirds often enhances landscape shots, so you can practice using it and get some great shots at the same time.
