

Leading Lines

Description:

Create a photograph with leading lines that guide the viewer's eye. The lines can either lead the viewer into the subject of the picture or else lead the viewer across the picture.

Keys to Success:

- Decide whether you want the subject of the picture to be the lines themselves or something else.
- Lines can be either actual or implied; man-made or natural.
- Don't overlook shadows and water trails as options.
- Look for many things in a row to use as a line.

There are lines everywhere. This assignment will help you see them, and help you use them in your photographs.
