Beware, you CAN'T leave private or company pension in a Will

- Died and not taken pension? Provider/trustee decides what to do
- Do an 'Expression of Wishes' / 'Nomination Form' (ensure kept up to date)

Store your Will safely

- Many solicitors store for free. If not, keep in safe & accessible place

Think about digital legacy too.com (online photos, blog, docs, soc media)

- List & include digital assets in your Will (beneficiaries & soc media executor)
- Back up your most important things (preferably on external hard drive)
- Record decisions via DigitalLegacyAssociation.org template
- Note 'executor' on platforms that allow (Apple, Facebook, Google-ish)

DIGITAL LEGACY DOCUMENT

- *This document should contain a list of logins and passwords to your digital devices and websites. It may reference other password managers, as necessary.*
- *You could store a printed copy of this document with your will.*
- *You could save the document onto a flash drive so you do not have a copy on your computer or mobile device as it will contain a lot of sensitive data.*
- *The flash drive could be stored either with your will or with your “little black book with your passwords in”*
- *Try and include as much information as required for your executor to get access to your data. Maybe do a “dry run” as if you were the executor.*

Computer and Mobile Device Logins

Biometrics may be unavailable so you will need to know the iPhone/iPad or Android passcode. This should be recorded in the Digital Legacy Document

Device : iPhone/iPad or Android Device

Password : 1234

Email logins

Next to the device logins this would be the next most important data. You will need to record the following

Login : me@gmail.com

Email Password : Monkey123

2FA : SMS or Authenticator App on mobile device

Financial Institutions

Lasting Power of Attorney (LPA) gives you legal right to access the persons account, but you will still need to know the on-line banking details.

Institution name : Lloyds Bank

Login : Account Number

Password : Monkey123

2FA : SMS or Authenticator App on mobile device

Utilities

Most utilities such as Gas, Electricity, Internet, SKY TV have moved their customers to paper-less accounts so it will be necessary to record login details for each service.

Utility name : Octopus Energy

Login : Account Number

Password : Monkey123

2FA : SMS or Email

What if something fails

If you have a failure of for example, you loss internet connection, you should provide some basic tests like where it the internet router if and how to turn it off and on. The same for the SKY or BT internet box. Also record the contact details from the provider along with any account or passwords that may be required to log a problem.

Digital Photos

Digital photos can be held in different locations. You may have some downloaded from an old digital camera on your Computer. You may have some on your mobile device. You may have some in the cloud via google photos, OneDrive or Dropbox.

Photos taken on a mobile device are normally automatically uploaded to the relevant cloud storage. So, you need to make sure you have recorded the necessary credentials to access them.

Digital Photos continued..

If you have an iPhone or iPad and a windows Computer you can install the iCloud app from the Microsoft App Store. This allows you to transfer photos from iCloud to your Computer automatically.

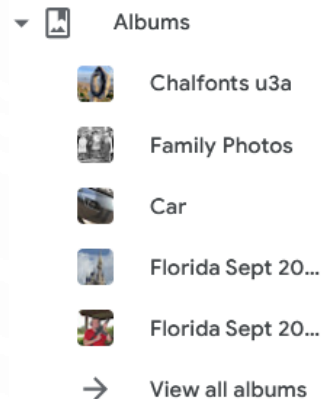


Digital Photos continued..

If you have an Android device it, should, sync to Google Photos if it has been configured correctly. It should be easy to check if you have the same photos on the device as you have on Google Drive. Some phones come with vendor software, but you can install Google Photos from their App Store.






There is currently no automatic way to synchronise google photos with your PC. You can however manually download photos from the google photos. It is recommended to first place the photos into albums and then you can download the whole album.





Digital Music and Videos...

If you have an iPhone or iPad you can install iTunes onto your computer and synchronise music between the two devices. If you have purchased music or videos from iTunes, they will be locked to the account used to purchase them. You may not be able to transfer this to a different account without converting the files first.
