Winchester Cathedral, located at the heart of the city surrounded by idyllic green spaces, is one of the most historically significant buildings in Britain. Built on the orders of William the Conqueror it boasts the longest medieval nave in Europe.

Jane Austen who was born, lived and died in the area now rests in the Cathedral together with famous monarchs and consorts. Our guide will tell us about the history of the Cathedral, its characters and events making our visit truly memorable.

The Cathedral Christmas Market is recognised as one of the best in Europe with its unique location, high quality exhibitors and bustling atmosphere. Christmas gifts, decorations and festive foods can be found in abundance!

Winchester has museums and art galleries including **The Winchester City Mill** situated on the River Ichen in the city centre. This Mill is owned by the **National Trust** and is a grade II listed building.



There will be plenty of time to visit and explore the city and enjoy a light snack or lunch in one of the many cafes, restaurants and pubs.
