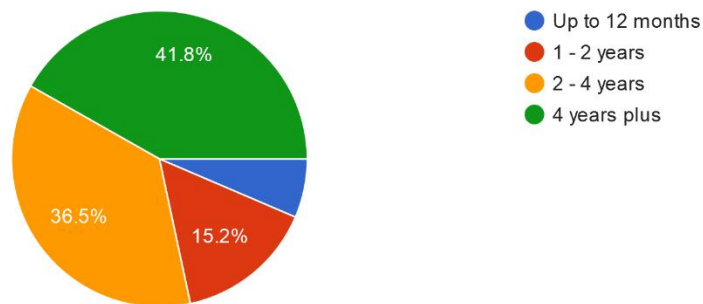

1 Membership

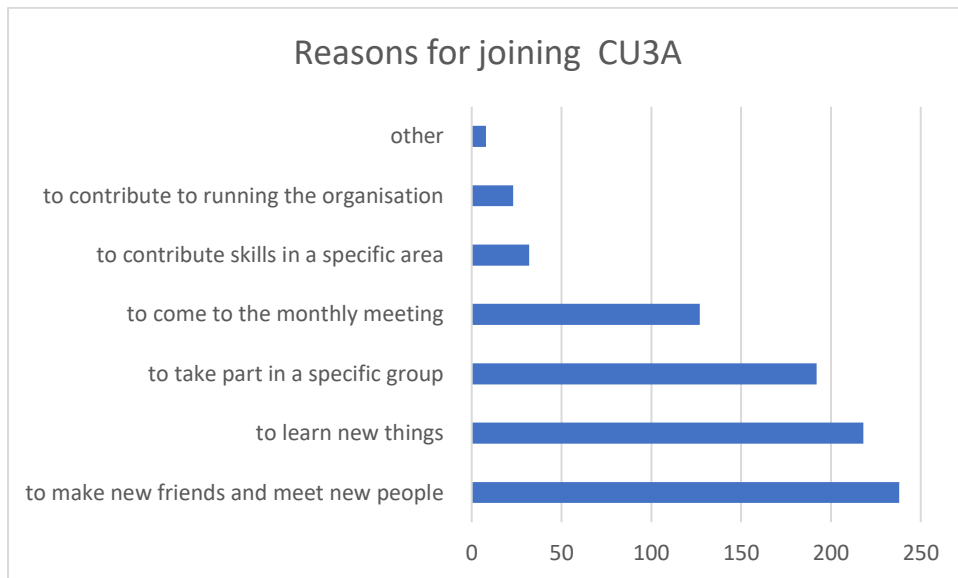
How long have you been a member of CU3A?

342 responses



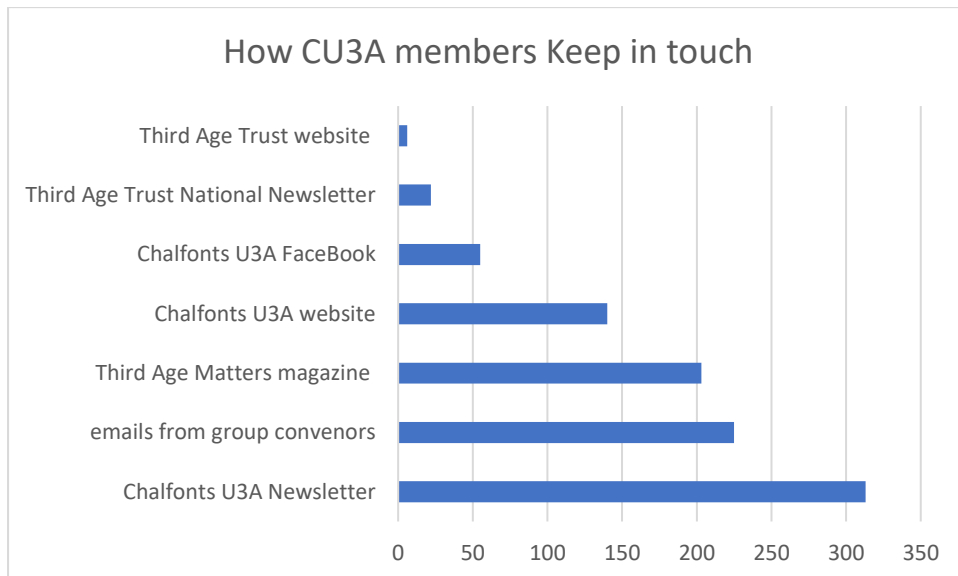
Why did you join U3A?

341 responses



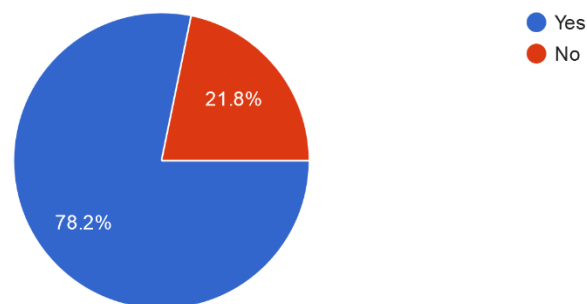
2 Keeping in Touch.

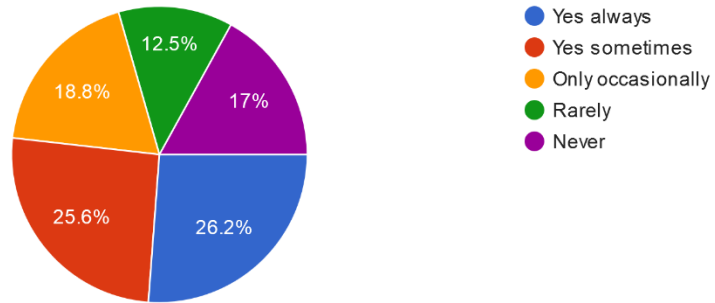

3 Monthly Members meetings

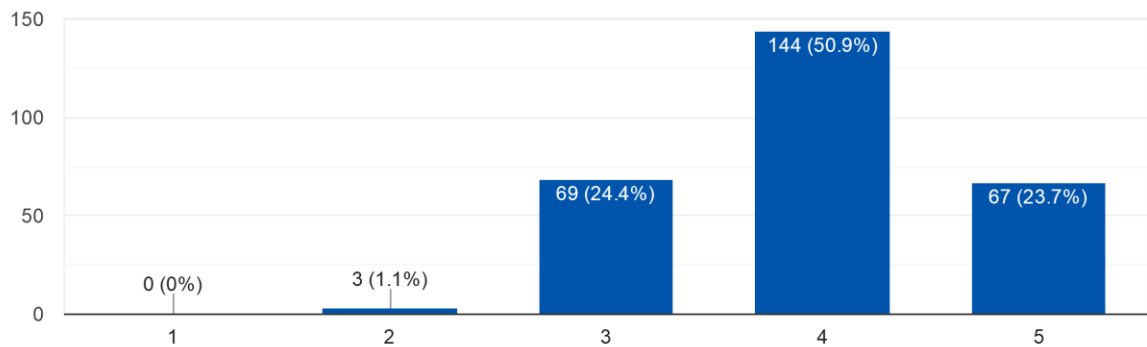
In pre Covid 19 times did you attend the Chalfonts U3A monthly members meeting?

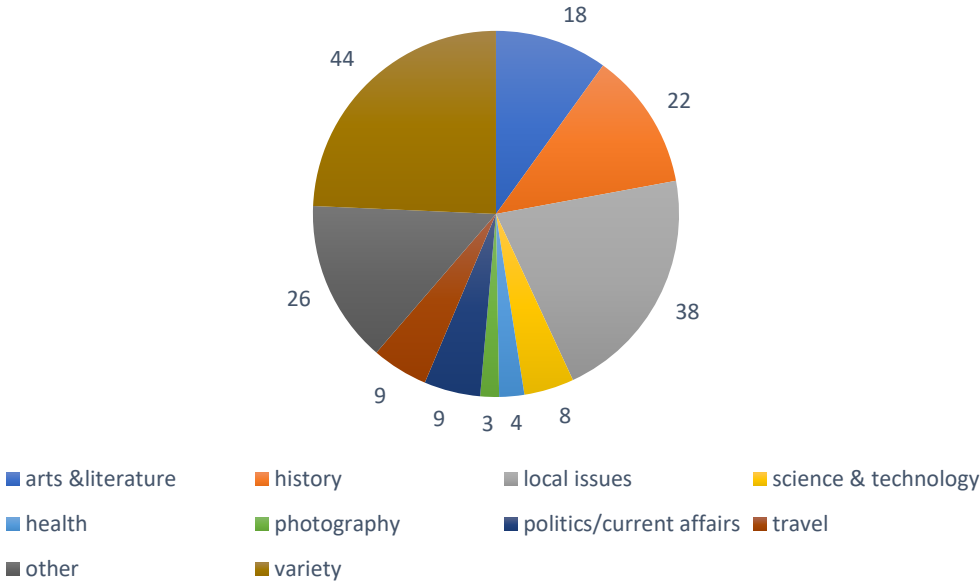


Please rate how much in general you enjoyed the meetings: from 1-5, with 1 being poor and 5 being excellent

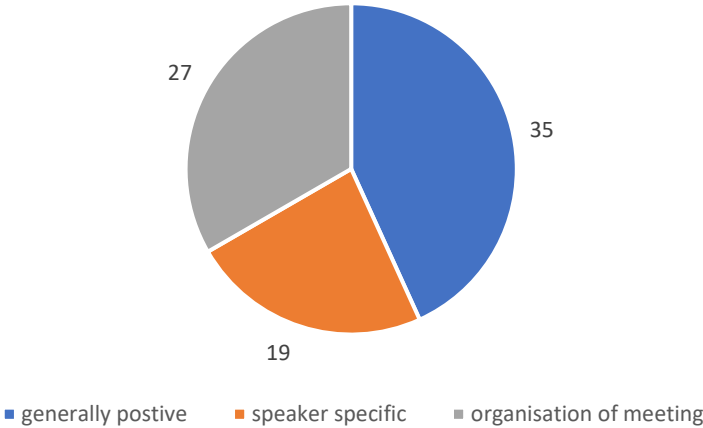

Other comments on monthly meetings



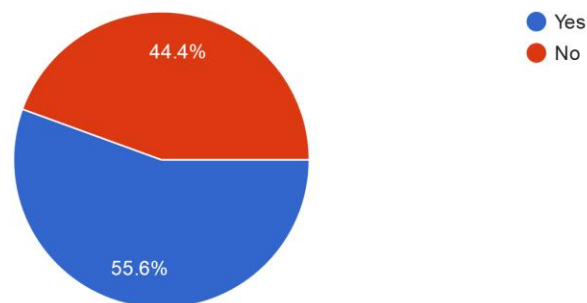
The main issues identified in respect of the organisation of the meeting were :

room hot , stuffy, and crowded ; difficulties hearing and with the microphones ;a request for decaf options; difficulty with car parking, need to improve meet and greet and encourage people on their own to meet up; mobility issues; a request for a different meeting day and a request for group meetings not to clash with monthly meeting.

Speakers Most of the feedback was positive , but a few members considered there had been a decline in the quality of recent speakers . Two wished to make sure that they always used visual material. An evaluation form for the speaker was suggested.

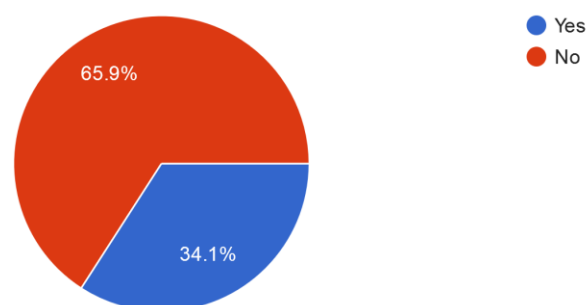
Would you be interested in some “How to do things” sessions - e.g. make an Easter decoration?

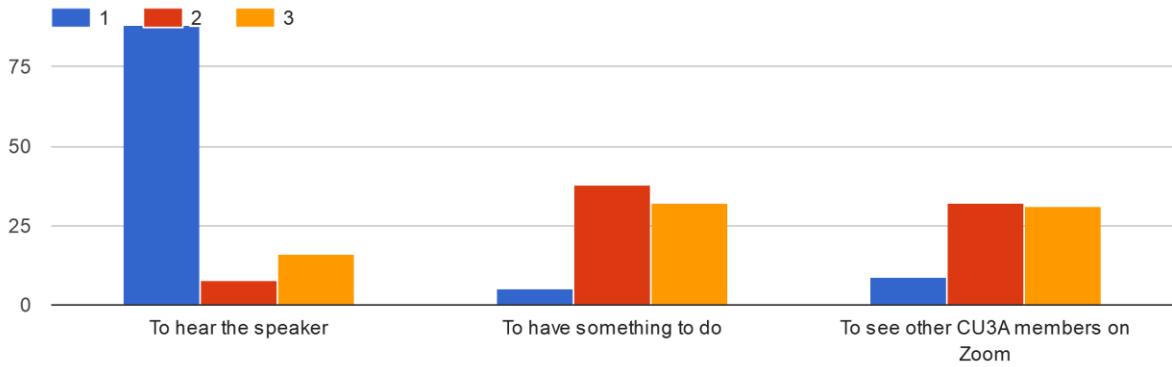


The monthly members meeting is now taking place on Zoom. Have you attended a monthly member meeting on Zoom?

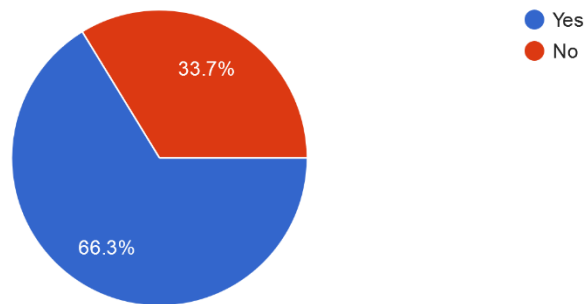


What did you see as the benefit of the meetings. Please rank in order of importance, with 1 most important and 3 the least important

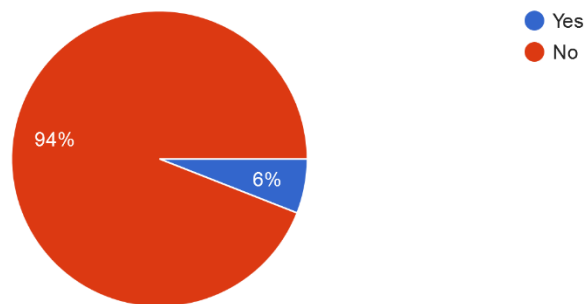

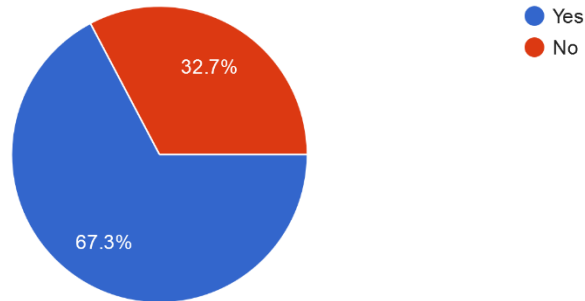


Have you joined any new groups over the last 6 months?

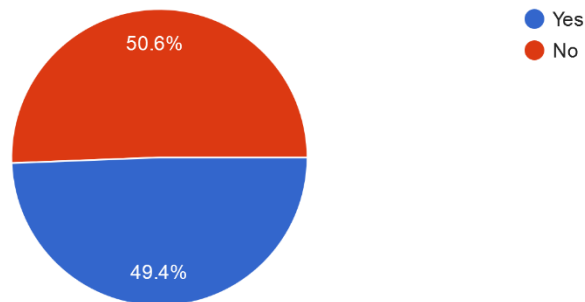
Are you aware of the study days offered by the Thames Valley Network?

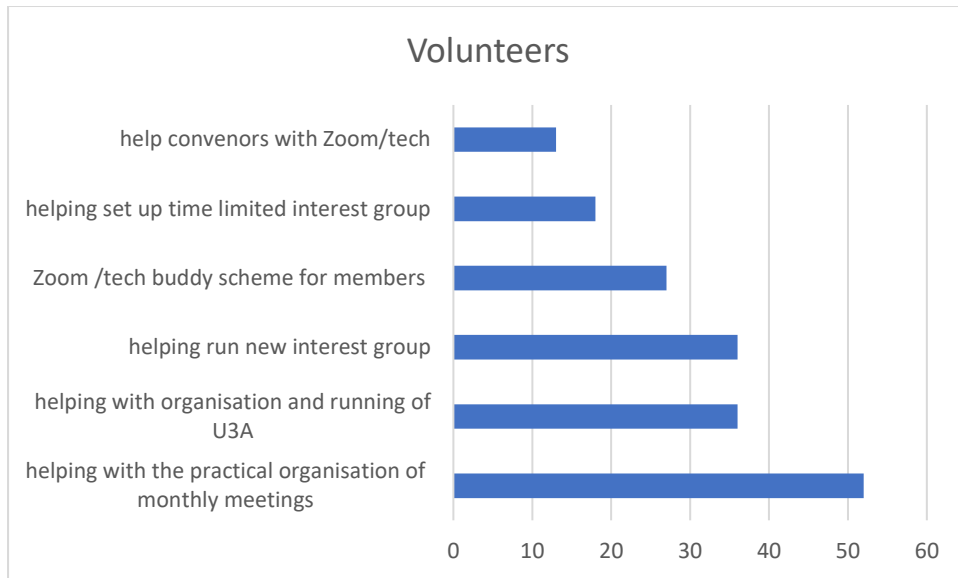
