Brooklands is steeped in history. Since it opened in 1907, through two World Wars, into the Jet Age and beyond, it is a place of great endeavour, achievements and has spawned many great pioneers, drivers, aviators and engineers. The Museum houses Brooklands Aircraft Factory, Flight Shed, Motoring Village, Aircraft Park, Stratosphere Chamber, Race Track, motorcycling, bike exhibits and the London Bus Museum and more!

With a private talk arranged, we shall learn about the VC10 and her Royal Connections. Timed tickets have been obtained for the Concorde Experience—a 30 minute visit aboard Concorde G-BBDG which includes a virtual flight DVD presentation, piloted by Mike Bannister. The 4D Theatre provides the closest experience any living person will have of “driving” around the Brooklands Race Track, at Le Mans or “flying” with the Red Arrows.

Our day allows for time to explore all the exhibition areas and to enjoy lunch in the Sunbeam Café which offers a wide range of hot meals, snacks and sandwiches.
