IMPORTANT: HOW TO FIND OUR NEW WEBSITE ONLINE!

If you use any search engine and type in "Chalfonts U3A" as a search term, our new website does not automatically appear at the top of the list of entries. Currently it's lying around seventh or eighth place on their first page. This is because the old website, which has now been removed entirely, is still being indexed by the special software used by search engines.
