## THE NEW CHALFONTS U3A CUSTOM-BUILT WEBSITE - WHAT IT DOES, AND HOW IT'S DESIGNED TO WORK

Our new custom-built website is there for all our members with internet access. At the top (for those not too familiar with the terminology it's called the **Header**) we have page links that help you to navigate the website. Briefly, some of these are:

The **HOME** page. This gives an overview of things that have happened. It has a link to the **Noticeboard**, which is also on the main header bar menu. Why not make the Noticeboard your first stop as here you will find the latest news. New additions to the board will happen fairly often. When a particular event is over it will be removed. So visit it frequently not to miss anything that might be of interest to you.

The **Header** menus are self-explanatory and cover **Interest Groups**, which can be found in both an alpha-list The **Membership** menu; anyone who wants to know about joining can find answers to their questions and also a Membership form. The **Events** tab gives information about the **Monthly Meetings** on a 'sub-menu'. This page shows guest speakers for three or four months ahead, and their subject. We also have a **Gallery**. We will put any pictures/videos we have inside a Year folder, 2015, 2016 etc. The galleries are in the early stages and are not yet complete as they are very time consuming to put together. We aim to have the galleries in place by spring 2017. There is a comprehensive **HELP** page. If a member wants to know about how the website works, the help page should do exactly that. Just below the Header section is the main **Content** area. It has a white background and this is where, when you visit any of the pages, the content for that page is displayed.

We want our website to act as a **HUB** for members. So, at the bottom the **Footer** has links to the **local media newspapers** in the South Bucks area. Also links to the **CSP Community Centre**, **Community Library** and the various **council websites** in Bucks. We also have lots of other U3A website information, including links about the worldwide U3A movement and to main media websites, e.g BBC/ITV and others members might find useful.

The easiest way to find out more is to explore the website for yourself. The life blood of the U3A movement is the various Interest groups, so there is a separate page for all of these giving information about meeting day, time, frequency and other information relevant to the particular group. Each of the Interest Group pages then have links to 'more information' on the group, which states their objectives and what their group is all about. We can add other pages to any of the interest groups with relevant information about their topics.

Finally, if you have friends who may be interested in knowing more about Chalfonts U3A the easiest way to help them, rather than spending hours of your time explaining what the U3A is all about (if they have internet access), is to ask them to visit our **Membership** page on the website.
