December's Monthly Meeting - David Tomkins - Magician


At our final monthly meeting of the year we were entertained by a wonderful magician, David Tomkins.


Another trick saw one of our members have a hole drilled in her tummy, though we should say


that while he was doing this incredible bit of magic, she was laughing and giggling.
