## 14 January 2026 at 2pm – Across Africa in a Classic Aston Martin

The route took them from the Atlantic Coast, through Namibia, Botswana, Zambia and Zimbabwe to Mozambique and the Indian Ocean via Eswatini and South Africa before returning to their starting point of Cape Town.

## 11 February 2026 at 2pm – A is for Arsenic: The Poisons of Agatha Christie

Dr Kathryn Harkup, a former chemist turned writer and science communicator, talks about how Agatha Christie revelled in the use of poison to kill off unfortunate victims in her books; indeed, she employed it more than any other murder method, with the poison itself often being a central part of the novel.

This talk looks at how the writer used her extensive knowledge of drugs and medicines mixed with real life cases to create her brilliantly plotted crime novels. Her poisons were picked with care, often providing vital clues to the discovery of the murderer. We will look at 'howdunnit' but whodunnit is for you to find out.

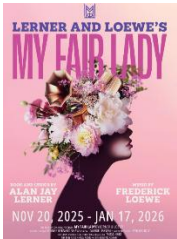
## Theatre Group

## London Walks

On Wednesday 19th November, a bitterly cold day, we met our guide Robert Hulbert for the Bermondsey to Rotherhithe Historical Walk.

Rotherhithe Village was defined by its history as a port for centuries and the riverbank once heaved with mighty sailing ships from Elizabethan times onwards.



It also attracted drinking, violence and vice. During the Second World War, much of the area was destroyed, and the introduction of container ships meant that trade moved to Tilbury, which could accommodate such large vessels, leaving the area as one of the poorest in the capital.

Along our path we saw statues celebrating the work of Alfred and Ada Slater, who, in the early 1900's worked in this area providing healthcare to the poor. Conditions were really bad and their own daughter caught scarlet fever, and died aged 10 (her statue is shown here), but the Slaters continued to work and campaign for better healthcare. Their work (along with that in South Wales) is thought to be a blueprint for the NHS.



In the 1980s the area began to transform, warehouses were converted and new development began around the dockland areas.

Towards the end of our walk we passed a pub that used to be called The Spread Eagle, but was renamed The Mayflower in the 1980's to reflect the fact that this is where the Mayflower started its journey taking The Pilgrim Fathers to America in July 1620. Inside the pub there is a Descendants Book which is available on request to those with family connections to the original Pilgrim Fathers from the Mayflower voyage, a great attraction for American tourists!
